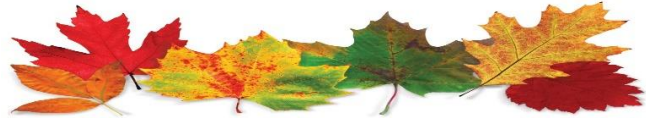

## Fall Treats

### Spider Cupcakes

- 1 box of chocolate cake mix
- Chocolate frosting
- 2 Oreo cookies
- 1 Bag of M&Ms

Heat oven to 375°F. Place paper baking cup in each of 24 regular-size muffin cups. Make and bake cake mix as directed on box for cupcakes. Cool 10 minutes; remove from pans to cooling racks. Cool completely, about 30 minutes. Spread chocolate frosting and cover with crushed Oreo cookies, and place black licorice as legs and 2 M&M for eyes.



### Hotdog Mummies

- 1 tube of Crescent rolls
- One packet of hotdogs
- Mustard or ketchup

Buy one tube of crescent dough, unroll the crescent dough and cut it into strips. Remove the hot dogs from the package and wrap them with the strips. Bake at 350 degrees for 14-17 min. or until the dough is golden brown. Let them cool then add Ketchup or mustard eyes.
